# COVID 19 UPDATE

Recent articles in our local news media have made us aware of a sharp increase in COVID-19 hospitalizations over the past three weeks. Beaufort Memorial Hospital's CEO has indicated that none of the admissions have been vaccinated. And a recent call to the hospital confirmed that they are at full capacity.

As we begin our fall activities we want our congregation to be aware of the statistics related to the virus, particularly the high transmissibility of the Delta variant. The last thing we want to do is to cancel or cut back in-person worship services and other activities. And it is not our intent to try and influence anyone regarding whether or not to be vaccinated. 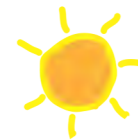
