Listening to Scripture

The Bakuna team purchased additional MP3 audio players, loaded them with recorded Scripture and sent them with an evangelist for village distribution. This man later reported that folks gathered in homes to listen in the evenings, with groups as large as ten hearing God's Word for the first time.

A Change of Heart

In the previous update, we mentioned that a believer's non-Christian husband had started listening to Scripture with her. As a follow-up, the team reports that this man still listens to God's Word at home and now often attends church. Furthermore, when he spends time at a local park, he brings the audio device and plays the Bible for the elderly people who congregate there. He has also indicated that he's willing to help the team distribute Scripture in this way.

Lord, provide a husband for Jennifer and grant her boldness in sharing the gospel with unbelieving family members. Give wisdom as Ruth deals with her abusive husband. Protect her Christian family members from government authorities.
