

What You Heard In the Word

- Nicodemus was a ruler of the Jews who went to see Jesus. He did not understand when Jesus told him that he must be born again to enter God's kingdom.
- Jesus told Nicodemus that he had come to save the world from the punishment of sin.
 Only those who believe in Jesus will have eternal life.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. What leader of the Jews came to visit Jesus at night? *Nicodemus*.
- 2. What did Jesus say a person must do to see the kingdom of God? *He must be born again*.
- 3. What did Jesus say being born again, spiritual birth, was like: waves, wind, or fire? *Wind*.
