

What You Heard In the Word

- Jesus traveled through Samaria. He met a Samaritan woman at a well and told her he could give her living water—eternal life.
- The woman believed Jesus was the Christ, the Savior, and immediately went to tell the townspeople about him. Many of them came to see Jesus and believed in him.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. How did the Samaritans and the Jews feel about each other? Most Jews and Samaritans didn't like each other and would not speak to each other.
- 2. Jesus was a Jew, and he spoke to the Samaritan woman. What kind of water did Jesus say he could give her? Living water.
- 3. What did Jesus mean by "living water"? Eternal life.
