What if your friend says that he is afraid to talk about Jesus to the rich kids at his school since he doesn't think they're interested? They seem to have everything they need. **What could you say?**

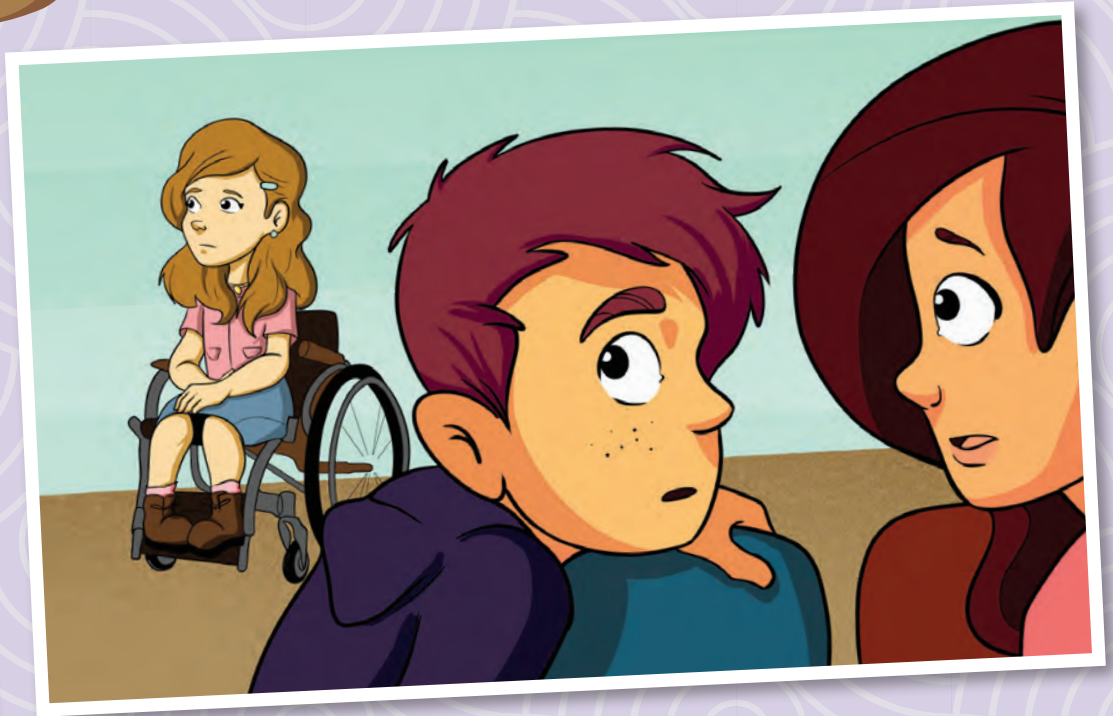
