

Bird Puppet

Materials

- Bird Face (next page)
- Signs (following page)
- Paper lunch bags for each student
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Glue
- Feathers

Instructions

Print and cut out one copy of the Bird Face and one sign for each student or have students do the cutting. Have students color the sign and the Bird Face pieces.

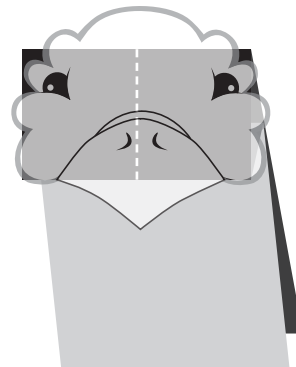
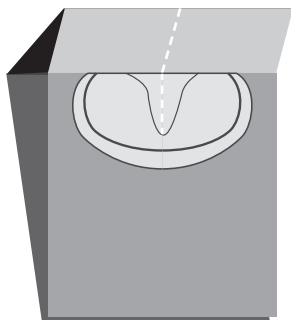
Lay the lunch bag flat with the flap showing at the top. Glue the sign at the bottom of the bag. Glue the bottom of the mouth under the flap, centering it at the crease. Glue the upper face on top of the flap, matching the bottom edge of the face with the edge of the flap, allowing the tip of the beak to extend below the edge. (See illustrations below.) Run your finger under the flap to make sure it is not glued down. Have students decorate their bird with feathers. Allow glue to dry before using the puppets.

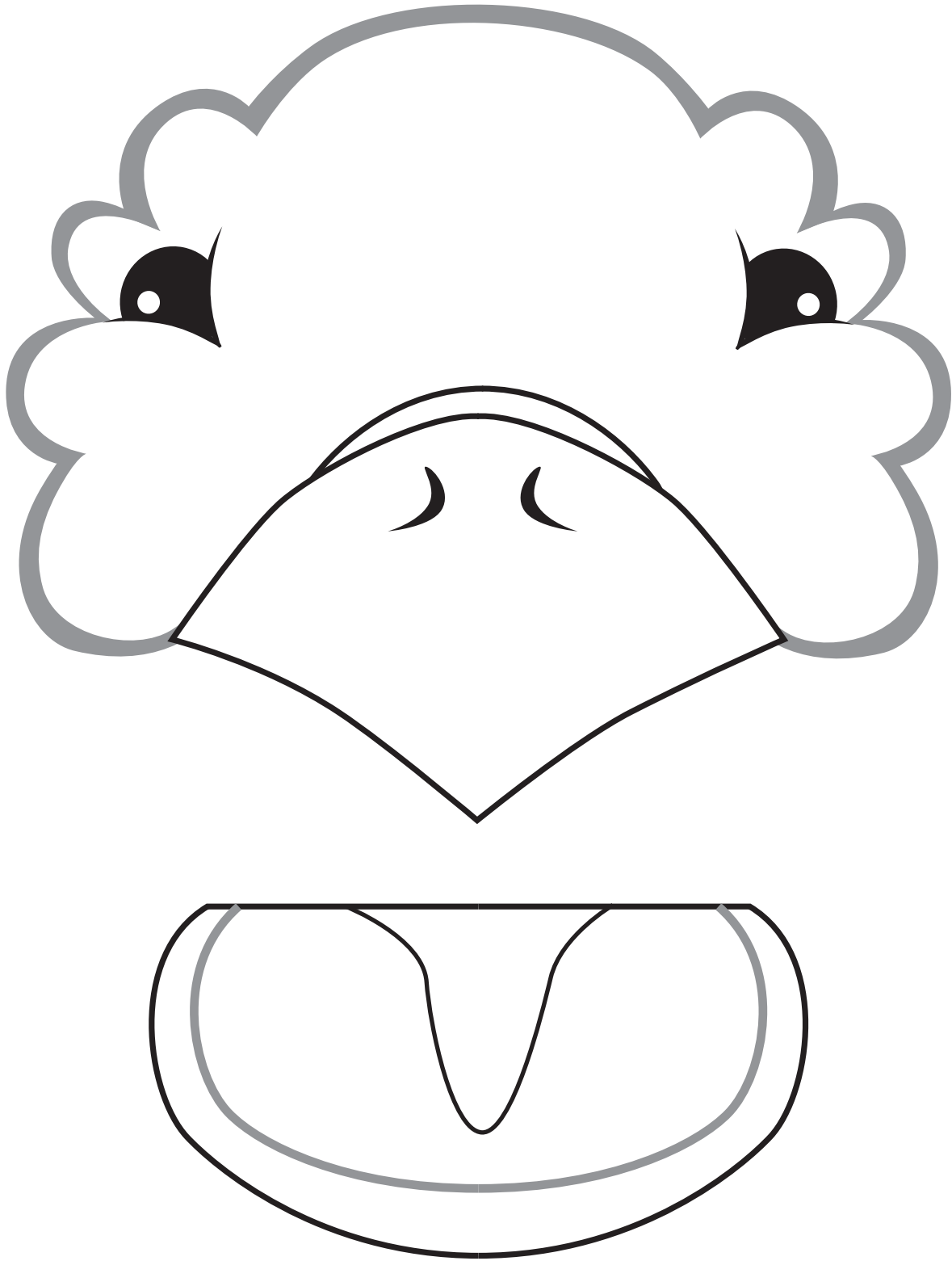


Suggested Discussion
