



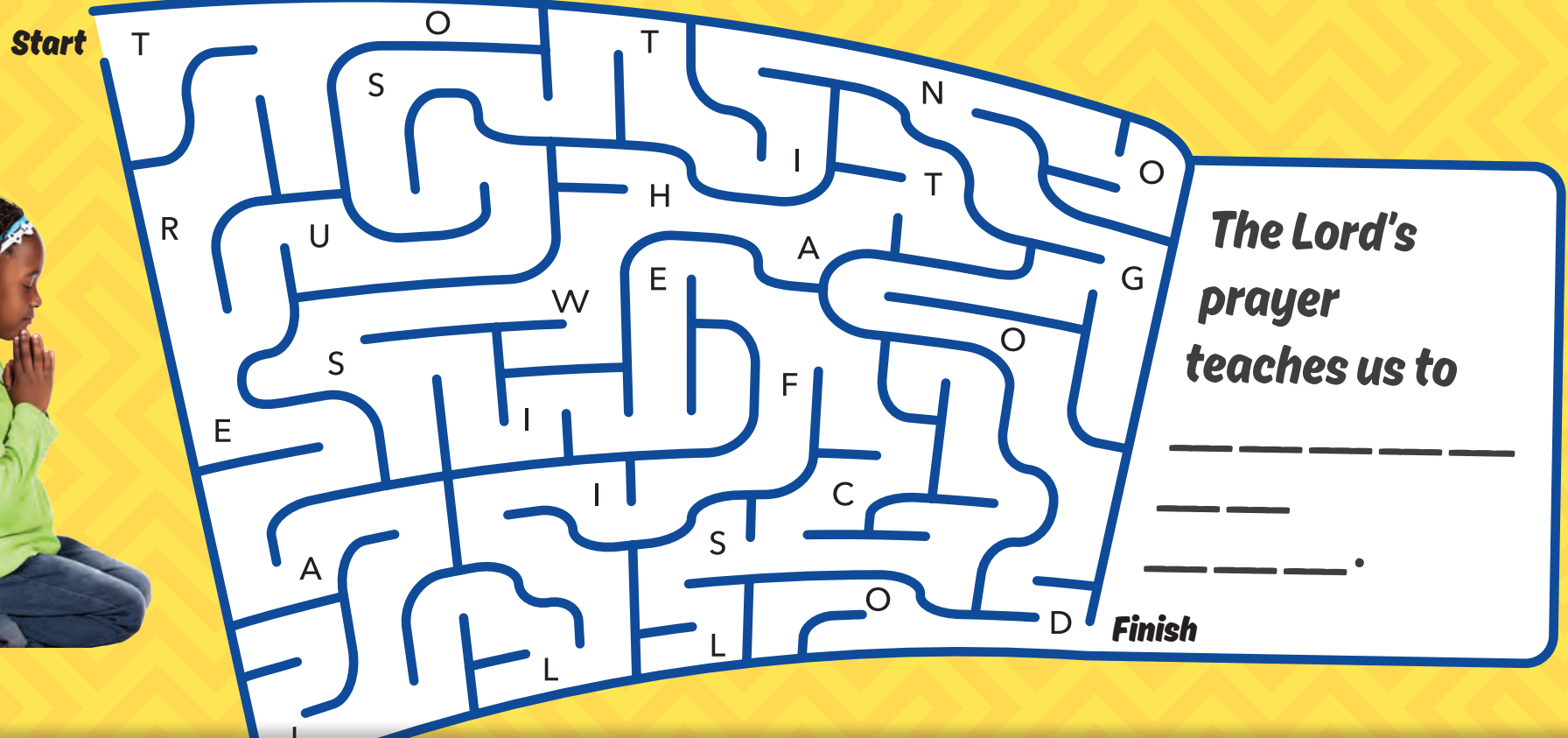

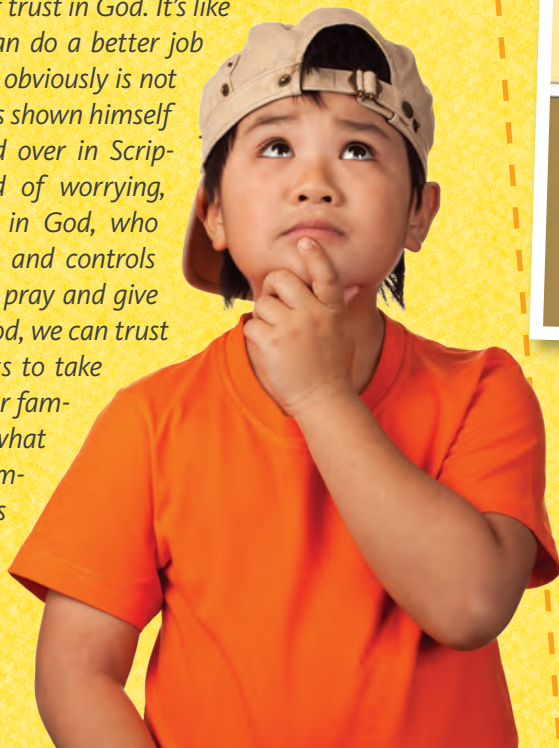
👂 What You Heard *In the Word*

What if your friend says he's always worried that something bad will happen to someone in his family? **What could you say?**

It is easy to worry about people we care about. But a lot of the things we worry about we can't control or change. That's why Jesus said not to be anxious because each day has its own troubles. When we worry, we are showing a lack of trust in God. It's like telling God, "I can do a better job than you," which obviously is not true. But God has shown himself faithful over and over in Scripture. So, instead of worrying, we should trust in God, who knows all things and controls all things. As we pray and give our worries to God, we can trust in his faithfulness to take care of us and our family. He knows what we need and promises to be with us no matter what happens.
