

telling God, "I can do a better job than you," which obviously is not true. But God has shown himself faithful over and over in Scripture. So, instead of worrying, we should trust in God, who knows all things and controls all things. As we pray and give our worries to God. we can trust in his faithfulness to take care of us and our family. He knows what we need and promises to be with us no matter what happens.
