

Luke 7:13–15; Mark 5 (selected verses)

Jairus begged Jesus to come heal his daughter. Lead Jesus to Jairus' house. What happened to the girl before Jesus got there? What did Jesus do for her?



What You Heard In the Word

- Jesus showed love and his power by raising a woman's son and Jairus' daughter from the dead.
- Jesus gives us hope because he conquered death when he rose from the dead. Jesus promised that at the consummation there will be no more death.

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

- 1. What did Jesus do to bring the woman's son back to life? *He commanded him to rise*.
- 2. Who believed that Jesus could heal his daughter? *Jairus*.
- 3. What did Jesus do to raise Jairus' daughter from the dead? *He took her hand and told her to rise.*
