

# Review Questions

## K–1<sup>st</sup> Review Questions

1. What was wrong with the man brought to Jesus? *He was blind and mute; he couldn't see or talk.*
2. Who had control of the blind and mute man: God, a demon, or no one? *A demon.*
3. What is a demon: an evil spirit, a good spirit, or a bad person? *An evil spirit (who serves Satan).*
4. What did Jesus do for the man? *He healed him; he made the demon leave so he could see and speak.*
5. When the people saw Jesus' power, who did they think he was: a great teacher, a magician, or the promised Messiah? *The promised Messiah (the Son of David).*
6. Who did the Pharisees say gave Jesus his power over the demon: God, the prince of the kingdom, or the prince of demons? *The prince of demons.*
7. Who is the prince of demons? *Satan.*
8. Jesus said if his power came from Satan, then Satan's kingdom would be divided, working together, or strong? *Divided.*
9. What happens to a divided kingdom? *It will not stand; it will fall.*
10. Where did Jesus' power come from? *God.*
11. Jesus said a tree is known by its branches, fruit, or roots? *Fruit.*
12. What two types of fruit did Jesus talk about? *Good and bad/evil.*
13. What is the fruit in our lives? *The things we say and do/how we speak and act.*
14. Where do our words and actions come from? *From inside, from the heart.*
15. How can we make our hearts right with God? *Turn from our sins and trust Jesus.*
16. Who does God give us to help us obey him and have good fruit? *His Holy Spirit.*
17. Who can finish the memory verse? "Therefore do not be anxious, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' But . . ." (Allow several students to answer.) *seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.*

## Pre-K Review Questions

1. What was the blind and mute man not able to do? *He couldn't see or talk.*
2. Who had control of the blind and mute man: God, a demon, or no one? *A demon.*
3. What is a demon: an evil spirit, a good spirit, or a bad person? *An evil spirit (who serves Satan).*
4. Who healed the man by making the demon leave? *Jesus.*
5. Where did the Pharisees say Jesus got his power: from God, the king, or Satan? *Satan.*
6. When a group is divided, are they working together or against each other? *Against each other.*
7. What would happen to Satan's kingdom if he helped Jesus? *It would fall.*
8. Where did Jesus' power come from: Satan or God? *God.*
9. Jesus said you can tell if a tree is good or bad by its branches, fruit, or leaves? *Fruit.*
10. What two types of fruit did Jesus talk about? *Good and bad/evil.*
11. What is the fruit in our lives that Jesus was talking about? Bananas and apples or the things we say and do? *The things we say and do.*
12. Where do our words and actions come from: the heart, the eyes, or the feet? *From the heart/from the inside.*
13. What must we turn away from to make our hearts right with God? *Our sins.*
14. To be right with God, we must believe in whom? *Jesus.*
15. Who does God give us to help us obey him and have good fruit? *His Holy Spirit.*
16. Who can finish the first half of the memory verse? "Therefore do not be anxious, saying, . . ." (Allow several students to answer.) *"What shall we eat?" or "What shall we drink?" or "What shall we wear?"*
