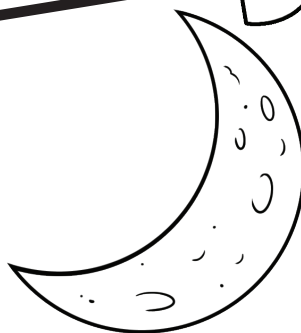

care for him?

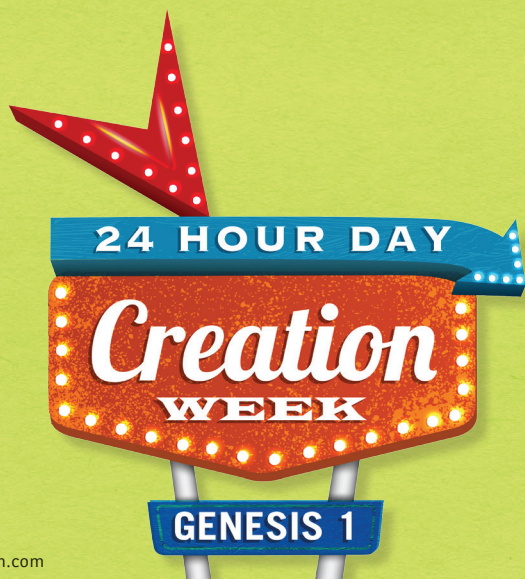


What You Heard *In the Word*

- There is one morning and one evening in one day. God created everything in six days.
- God made plants with seeds so they could grow more plants just like them. They were created to reproduce “according to their kinds.”

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What did God create on Day 1? *Light, day, and night.*
2. What happened on the second day? *God made the sky above and water below.*
3. What did God make on the third day? *Dry land and plants.*
4. What did God create on Day 4? *Sun, moon, stars, and planets.*
