Break the Ice:

1. When was a time that you felt like you were dying of thirst?
2. What did it feel like when you finally got a drink?

What do I think?

1. Do you think prophecy being fulfilled in the Bible is important? Why/why not?
2. What does it mean to you to “thirst for righteousness?”
3. Do you believe that you can make a difference in this world? How?

What does God say?

1. Read Exodus 12:21-22 – How does this picture what Jesus did on the cross?
2. Why are all these little details so important?
3. Read John 4:7-15 – What is the living water that Jesus offers the woman?
4. What does it mean then that you will never thirst if you drink of the living water?

What steps will I take?

1. How can you better thirst for souls like Jesus did?
2. What can you do to better thirst for righteousness?

Challenge:

This week, spend time thinking about what Christ has done for you on the cross. Think about how even with two simple words, Jesus was fulfilling prophecy. Ask God to help you have a thirst for souls and a thirst for righteousness. Ask Him to show you someone with whom you can share the living water that you have. Look for opportunities to help and serve people who are in need. Spend time thanking God that Jesus fully accomplished His work on the cross of paying for your sins.
