- 2. Why do you think so many people want to disconnect from the Old Testament?
- 3. What are some of the important aspect of the Old Testament that stand out to you?

What does God say?

- 1. Read Psalm 119:97-104 Why does David say he loves God's law?
- 2. What are the outcomes of David "meditating" on God's Word?
- 3. Read Psalm 119: 105-112 In your own words, what does David mean in verse 105?
- 4. Even in bad times, when David reads, understands and obeys God's Word, what are the outcomes in verses 110 and 111?

What steps will I take?

- 1. How can you better view and come to love all of the Bible as God's inspired word to you?
- 2. How can you be better prepared to speak for the relevancy of the Bible?
