- We will visit Capernaum, where Jesus preached and performed most of His Galilean miracles.
- We will take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee where Jesus stilled the sea, walked on the water, and commanded a herd of demonically possessed swine to drown.
- We will visit the famous caves where the Dead Sea scrolls were found.
- We will spend time floating on the Dead Sea.

Imagine seeing the same landscape that Jesus saw, being baptized in the Jordan River, having a communion service at Golgotha, or singing at the Garden Tomb where the Lord was raised from the dead.

Come with us on this amazing journey May 11th - May 21st. You will make memories that last a lifetime. And you will never read the Bible the same way again!

DAY 1 - DEPART U.S.A.

Tour members will meet for the flight to Israel. On the flight, we will enjoy dinner and the on-board entertainment as we prepare to walk where Jesus walked in a land that uniquely contrasts modern life with the ancient world.

DAY 2 - SHALOM AND WELCOME TO ISRAEL!

Upon landing at Ben Gurion International Airport in the afternoon, we meet our Israeli tour guide and are escorted to the bus waiting to take us to our hotel in nearby **Netanya**, in the territory allotted to the tribe of Manasseh. We will check-in for dinner and spend the night in this beautiful city overlooking the Mediterranean Sea, known in the Bible as the Great Sea.

DAY 3 - CAESAREA, MT. CARMEL, DRUZE VILLAGE, CANA, NAZARETH, GALILEE

This morning we will depart for the Galilee, visiting Biblical sites at **Caesarea** (where Peter proclaimed the Good News to Cornelius, the Roman Centurion - Acts 10), and **Mt. Carmel** (where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal - 1 Kings 18). We drive through **Cana** (location of Jesus' first miracle - John 2). Lunch (included) is at the **Druze Village**. We then continue to **Nazareth** (Jesus' childhood home) and visit the "**Nazareth Village**" with a detailed explanation of what life was like during the time of Jesus. We will visit the **Mt. of Precipice**, where Jesus was officially rejected by his hometown people. The day ends in **Tiberias** with dinner and overnight accommodations on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

DAY 4 – GALILEE, MT. OF BEATITUDES, GOLAN HEIGHTS, CAESAREA PHILIPPI, TEL DAN, BOAT RIDE

Watching the sun rise over the **Sea of Galilee** is breathtaking! First, we will proceed to the **Mt. of Beatitudes** where Jesus preached His famous Sermon on the Mount. Then, we travel north to the beautifully landscaped **Golan Heights** to better understand the strategic importance of this region to the security of Israel. We then head to the **Mt. Bental** overlook. From this former military base, we can look into Syria and learn about the village of **Kunetra** and the 1967 & 1973 wars. Then on to **Caesarea Philippi** where Peter confessed "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16: 13-16). Nearby is the amazing nature preserve, **Tel Dan**, site of the altar of Jeroboam and one of ancient Israel's boundary markers (from Dan to Beersheba). We will also discuss the Biblical importance of this place. As we walk through this quiet national park and impressive Old Testament city we will hear the stories of disobedience that took place here (Judges 18, 1 Kings 12). Our lunch stop (included) gives us the option of the special St. Peter's Fish for those interested (not included in price). Next, we will board a replica wooden "**Jesus Boat**" to set sail on the **Sea of Galilee**. Here we will worship together and reflect on the miracles that took place on the water, in the water and around the sea. Dinner and overnight will be back in **Tiberias**.



DAY 5 - MAGDALA, TABGHA, CAPERNAUM, GILBOA, JERUSALEM

After breakfast, we visit **Magdala**, the home of Mary Magdalene. We will see the recent excavations of a synagogue from the time of Jesus. Next, we will head to **Tabgha** (the traditional site of the feeding of the 5000) and where the Lord Jesus met His disciples after the resurrection. Here He publicly reinstated Peter, thus the location of the **Church of the Primacy of St. Peter**. We will make our way to **Capernaum**, Jesus' headquarters for His early ministry, and where He performed so many of His miracles. We will have the opportunity to stand in the ruins of the synagogue where Jesus taught, and where He cast out a demon while visiting the place where Jesus healed Peter's mother-in-law. Here we will stop for lunch (included). Time permitting, we will stop for a brief devotional at **Gideon Springs**, where, at the bottom of **Mount Gilboa**, God reduced Gideon's army to only 300 men. We will then ascend to the majestic city of **Jerusalem** with a stop at **Mt. Scopus**. "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.' Our feet are standing within your gates, 0 Jerusalem" (Psalm 122: 1-2 NASB). Dinner and overnight are in **Jerusalem**.

DAY 6 – MT. OF OLIVES, PALM SUNDAY ROAD, GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE, CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE, BETHLEHEM

We begin the day on the beautiful **Mt. of Olives** to behold the breathtaking panorama of the Holy City. We will consider here the site of the Ascension and Jesus' return to this same mountain and will observe the famous **Temple Mount** for the third temple, the **Eastern Gate** that Jesus will walk through when He returns, along with other critical places from this vantage point. Our pilgrimage proceeds down the **Old Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** with its ancient olive grove, where we will meet in a private garden for a devotion and time of prayer. We will stop briefly at the **Church of Agony**, where tradition holds that Jesus prayed. We will then make our way into the old city through **St. Stephen's Gate**. Part of the Old City walk is the **Via Dolorosa** – including the pavement where Jesus stood while being tried by Pilate (the games of the soldiers are still etched in its stone floor), the **Ecce Homo Arch** (part of the gate of Herod's **Antonia Fortress** where Pilate interacted with the multitudes during Christ's examination by him), the **Ancient Cardo Maximo** and the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre**. We will also view the **Pool of Bethesda**, where Jesus performed the Sabbath day miracle. And we will sing in the ancient **Crusader Church of St. Anne**. After lunch (included) we will proceed to **Bethlehem**. We will pass by **Rachel's tomb** on the outskirts and visit the **Church of the Nativity**, the **Shepherd's Field**, and **the Cave of Jerome**. We will also have a visit to a local Baptist Church. We then return to our hotel in **Jerusalem** where we will have dinner and spend the night.



DAY 7 - CITY OF DAVID, HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL, SOUTHERN STEPS, JEWISH QUARTER, RABBINICAL TUNNELS

This morning we drive to the incredible archaeological find, the **City of David**. Here we take a short walk to **Hezekiah's Tunnel** (conditions permitting). Be sure to bring a flashlight and good water shoes with you as you will get wet walking through the tunnel. For those who prefer to stay dry, you will have the opportunity to see what is called "**Warren's Shaft**" by which David conquered the city from the Jebusites. If time permits, we will briefly visit the new excavations of the **Pool of Siloam**. Then we proceed to the **Southern Steps**, the access point to the temple in our Lord's time. Here we will sit on the steps and consider some of the great events that took place there. After lunch (included) we will walk to the holiest site in the whole Jewish world, the **Western** (**Wailing**) **Wall of Herod's temple**. Beyond the wall lies the 35-acre temple area purchased by King David (2 Samuel 24:18-25). On this site now stands **El-Aksa Mosque**, and the magnificent **Dome of the Rock** (the third holiest shrine in Islam). Then we walk along the **Rabbi's Tunnel** and come as close as is possible to the **Holy of Holies**. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 8 - YAD VASHEM, SHRINE OF THE BOOK, GARDEN TOMB

Today we will visit the city outside the walls. After breakfast we will pass by the **Supreme Court House**, **the Knesset** (Israeli Parliament) and the famous **Rose Garden** on the way to the **Yad Vashem Memorial**. Here we will receive a personal tour with orthodox **Rabbi Hanoch Teller**, a renowned author and Holocaust scholar. After lunch (included), we will enjoy the world-famous **Israel Museum**, where we will gain some insights into the Jerusalem of Jesus' day by looking at a first century model of the city. This is also the location of the **Shrine of the Book** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** are housed including a display of the book of Isaiah. We will conclude the day with the **Lord's Table** as we reflect on the agony of the crucifixion at the **Place of the Skull** and the victory of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**. We will return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9 - QUMRAN, EIN GEDI, MASADA, DEAD SEA

After breakfast we will depart Jerusalem in the direction of Jericho, a descent of 4,000 feet in 13 miles. Our first stop will be at **Qumran**, the location of the caves where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered in 1947 after being hidden for 19 centuries by the Essenes who copied them. From there we will travel to **Ein Gedi**, the rock refuge where David penned many of the psalms and where he hid from King Saul. After lunch (included) we will cable car to the top of **Masada**, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod the Great that later became the final tragic stronghold of the Jewish rebellion against the Romans. Here we will survey the ruins of fortifications, waterworks, a synagogue and Herod's luxurious palace. We will then go to the shores of the **Dead Sea** to our hotel where we will experience the salt and mineral laden waters at the lowest point on earth.



DAY 10 – LEISURE AT THE DEAD SEA, QSAR EL-YAHUD, ELAH VALLEY, JAFFA, FAREWELL DINNER, BEN GURION AIRPORT

This morning we will have leisure time at the Dead Sea to enjoy floating in the water and the hotel spa (some services not included). After lunch (included), we depart for the Jordan River. Our first stop will be **Qasr el-Yahud** on the Jordan River for a service for all those interested in being baptized. This part of the Jordan River is in the very area where Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist. And this is the spot considered by the Hebrews to be the place where the Israelites crossed the Jordan River and where Elijah the Prophet ascended to heaven. We then drive to the **Elah Valley** and the brook where David confronted and slew the giant Goliath. From here, we proceed to **Jaffa**, where Peter stayed at the house of Simon the Tanner and was given the vision from God to preach to Cornelius. This is also the port where Jonah fled from his call from God and boarded a ship to Tarshish. The day will culminate in a tour of the flea market and an unforgettable **Farewell Dinner** before we make our way back to Ben Gurion Airport for the flight back to the U.S.A.

DAY 11 - ARRIVE BACK IN U.S.A.

We arrive back to the U.S.A. at the close of a memorable tour. We take home deep-seated visuals of the places that we visited such that we will never read the Bible again in the same way.

* COVID-19 Indications are that proof of having been vaccinated will be required for entry into the country. Please keep that in mind as you consider taking part in this magnificent tour. Many countries are also requiring or highly recommending the purchase of travel insurance prior to arrival. While we do our very best at making sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to; air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your tour leader and tour guide.

THE FINE PRINT ENROLLMENT IN AND PAYMENT OF YOUR DEPOSIT FOR THE TOUR, CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY.

INCLUDED IN PRICE

1) Round trip airfare per brochure, deluxe motor coaches, First Class / Superior First Class hotels, guided sightseeing, entrance fees to sites visited, breakfast & dinner daily per brochure, 8 lunches; 2) Taxes and fuel charges totaling \$595 USD comprised of \$264.60 for fuel charges (subject to increase by airline up to 30 days prior to departure) and \$330.40 for taxes (including federal inspection fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigrations; international air transportation tax; agricultural tax; other per person taxes imposed by government entities; airport taxes and fees including the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person); 3) Gratuities of \$195 for tour guide or cruise director, local host, driver, local guides, and/or ships' crew; gratuities on ferries, and cruise ships.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Not included in your package are passports, visas, COVID-19 tests, vaccinations, laundry, lunches, telephone, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, and food outside of the contracted tour operator menu as presented at a hotel or restaurant (these extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel, or restaurant), airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, porterage at airports, travel insurance, excess baggage fees, any fees or fuel surcharges imposed by the airlines after the date you register for your trip, and all other items not specifically mentioned.

PAYMENT:

A full deposit of \$500 per person is required at time of registration. Final payment must be made in the form of a check (credit cards are only accepted for initial deposit, any remaining payments must be in check form) and is due no later than 90-days prior to departure. Registrations received after 90-days prior to departure must be accompanied by full payment. There may be a late fee of \$195 for all payments or new registrations 5-60 days prior to departure. All tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 20 passengers for prices to be valid. The following supplements may apply for smaller groups: 19-15 travelers, a \$150 per person supplement; 14-10 travelers, a \$195 per person supplement. If group size is less than 10 travelers, the tour may be cancelled due to lack of participation. If final (full) payment is not received by imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as imagine) 60-days prior to departure, you will be automatically cancelled from the tour and your initial deposit of \$500 will be forfeited and additional fees may apply. imagine reserves the right to add a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the shekel or euro based on foreign exchange rates in effect on date (08/12/21) when your tour was booked by your tour leader/church. All payments are required in US Funds.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two persons sharing a room). When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. While *imagine* will try to match roommates, we cannot guarantee one will be available. Roommates may be assigned as late as 60 days prior to departure. If one is not available or if you request a single room, there will be a single room supplement charge: \$1052 for basic itinerary.

ITINERARY and CHANGES:

Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, *imagine* reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly. You will be notified in writing when possible. If itinerary changes necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged \$195 per night/per person (single rooms \$225/night). Meals for extra nights are not included. Any changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed, by the passenger, must be provided in writing to imagine no later than 100-days prior to departure and any extra costs incurred will be billed to the passenger. All deviations are subject to a standard fee of \$150 plus any applicable airline fees. All tours are final at 75-days prior to departure. No changes and/or additions may be made to the tour after that time.

LAND ONLY

Land Only price is \$4293 per person. Price does not include international flights. Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. We recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties, as the group's flights may change. Passengers changing from the regular tour to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$150 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS:

In order to keep prices low, *imagine* does not guarantee you will be on the most direct flights to your final destination. *imagine* also does not guarantee the group will be on the same flights, particularly if registering 90 days prior to departure. Flight routings are chosen by the airlines and not *imagine*. Airline tickets cannot be changed or refunded once issued. Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more flying together for entire itinerary. *imagine* is unable to use individual frequent flyer points to upgrade or accept them as partial payment for air transportation. Deviations by the passenger, from the group's scheduled flights, could result in different routings/air carriers. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after final payment has been made, may incur additional fees.

VISAS:

Applicable visas will be obtained by *imagine* for U.S. and Canadian Citizens only. All passengers who do not carry U.S. or Canadian Passports will be responsible for obtaining visas to the countries they are visiting. *imagine* is not responsible for non-U.S. & Canadian Passport holders.

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change by the airlines without advance notice. imagine is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend you purchase a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Any passenger cancelling from the day of registration to 100 days prior to departure will be charged a \$300 non-refundable administrative fee per person plus any airline penalties, if applicable. You will also be charged a single room fee if your cancellation forces your roommate into a single room from 59 days prior until the date of departure. The following charges also apply: 99-60 days = \$500; 59-45 days = \$1750; 44-25 days = 75% of total cost; 24 days to day of departure = 100% of total cost. All Cancellations must be received in writing. On or after the day of departure there is no refund for any services not used. We strongly recommend you purchase travel insurance. If imagine cancels the tour due to lack of participation, there will be a charge of \$150 deducted from the amount refunded to each passenger for administrative fees plus any airline penalties if applicable.

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

imagine and/or Trip leader reserve the right to re-schedule the dates of the Trip to future dates TBD due to governmental action, pandemic, or other circumstances beyond their control. Should that occur, all travelers will be rebooked for the new dates. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates may cancel their participation and will be assessed a cancellation fee of up to \$300 per person, plus any additional penalties/fees imposed by ground operator(s), airlines, or other vendors. Travelers can transfer to another available tour up to one year from their original departure date.

PASSPORT:

Each passenger is responsible for making sure that they have a **valid passport that has an expiration date at least six months after the date of return from their trip.**A copy of your valid passport must be submitted to our office by 90 days prior to departure.
