- C. Moses stretched out his hand over the sea
 - 1. The LORD swept the sea back by a strong east wind all night v.21
 - 2. Turned the sea into dry ground
 - 3. How far up the sea did this happen?
- D. The waters became like a wall to the Israelites v.22
- E. The Egyptians pursued v. 23-25
 - 1. All the chariots and went into the midst of the sea v.23
 - 2. The LORD brought the Egyptian army into "confusion"v.24, 25
 - 3. The Egyptians recognized that it was God fighting for the Israelites v.25
- F. God told Moses to stretch out his hand over the sea v. 26-29
 - 1. The waters returned to their normal state
 - 2. The entire Egyptian army that had gone into the sea was destroyed
 - 3. Remember God's words in 14:13b
 - 4. "But the sons of Israel walked on dry land through the midst of the sea" v. 29

G. The result? v. 30,31

- 1. "The LORD saved Israel that day" v.30
- 2. "The people feared the LORD and believed in the LORD"
- 3. "and "believed" in His servant Moses"
- 4. They sang a great song of victory and praise to God Ch. 15

- C. Their response to their disappointment v.2,3
 - 1. "grumbled" v.2
 - 2. "The whole congregation"
 - 3. "against Moses and Aaron"
 - 4. "Would that we had died by the LORD'S hand in the land of Egypt" v.3
 - 5. "when we sat by the pots of meat, when we ate bread to the full"

- 6. "for you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly" a. To starve us to death
 - b. Where did they get that idea from?
- D. Moses' response to their disappointment?
- E. God's response to their disappointment v.4-7
 - 1. "I will rain bread from heaven for you"
 - 2. "the people shall go out every day and gather a day's portion every day"
 - 3. "that I may test them whether or not they will walk in My instruction

 - 2. In the morning there was a layer of dew on the ground v.13

- 3. When the dew evaporated, there was a fine flake like thing
- 4. The people asked what is it? v. 15a. Moses said it is the bread which the LORD has given youb. manna
- I. Moses gave instructions v.16-21
 - 1. "Gather as much as he should eat
 - 2. "An omer apiece"
 - 3. "some gathered much and some little" v.17,18
 - 4. They were not to leave any of it till morning" v. 19
 - 5. Some did not listen to Moses and notice the result v.20
 - 6. As soon as the sun grew hot, the manna would disappear
 - 7. What stands out in this gathering?
- J. The Sabbath observed v.22-30
 - 1. What would this teach them about God?
 - 2. What would this teach them about their lives?
- K. An omer of Manna is kept v.32-36
 - 1. Why?
 - 2. They ate it for 40 years
