- 8. The Amalekites were the most powerful army in that area at the time
- 9. The Amalekites were nothing compared to Satan and his army Eph. 6:12

B. The timing of the attack

- 2. Often after great blessings and victories
- 3. Often when we are tired and worn out spiritually, physically, emotionally and mentally
- 4. Satan knows when we are vulnerable
- 5. 1 Peter 5:8
