

Learn the Word

What You Heard *In the Word*

Jesus brings good news to sinners. The good news is the gospel!

Ask your child these questions from today's lesson:

1. What is the bad news we read about in the Bible? Who is a sinner? *We are all sinners.*
2. What does the word "gospel" mean? *Good news.*
3. Who made a way for sinners to be forgiven? *Jesus.*
4. What does God promise to all who believe in Jesus? Where will they live forever? *In heaven.*
