

LIFE OF MOSES PLAGUES THAT SPEAK

FOURTH PLAGUE-FLIES-EXODUS 8:20-32

A. God again calls for Moses to rise early v. 20

1. To present himself to Pharaoh
2. His message is to be the same

B. Moses is to give Pharaoh a warning v. 21

1. "For if you do not"
2. "I will send a swarm of flies"
3. Notice where the swarm of flies would be

C. God set apart the land of Goshen v.22,23

1. "where my people live"
2. "I will put a division between My people and your people" v. 23
3. That should be a clear sign to Pharaoh

D. The result v.24

1. "great swarms"
2. "the land was laid waste"

E. Pharaoh offers a compromise v.25

F. Moses' response v.26,27

1. "It is not right to do so" v.26
2. "an abomination" v.26

3. "We must go a three days journey into the wilderness and sacrifice to the LORD" v.27

4. Why?

G. Pharaoh's next compromise v.28

1. "I will let you go...in the wilderness"

2. "only you shall not go very far"

3. "Make supplication for me"

H. Moses' response to Pharaoh v.29

1. "I shall make supplication"

2. "that the swarms....will depart... tomorrow"

3. "only do not let Pharaoh deal deceitfully again"

4. Whom is Moses saying that to?

5. Exodus 4:10-13

I. Moses makes supplication to the LORD v.30-32

1. God removed the swarms v. 31

2. Pharaoh's heart was hardened v. 32

J. What do you think about this plague?

FIFTH PLAGUE-LIVESTOCK DIE-EXODUS 9:1-7

A. The LORD again calls for Moses to speak to Pharaoh v.1

1. "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews"

2. "Let my people go, that they may serve me"

B. God's warning v.2-4

1. "For if you refuse" v.2
2. "the hand of the LORD" v.3
3. "will come with a severe pestilence"
4. "on your livestock"
5. But the LORD will make a distinction v.4
6. The LORD set a definite time, tomorrow v.5

C. The LORD did what He said he would v.6

D. The impact upon Egypt.

1. "All the livestock of Egypt died" v.6
2. Impact upon the economy
3. Impact upon the lives of the people of Egypt
4. Impact upon the religion of Egypt

E. Pharaoh's response v. 7

1. "sent"
2. "But his heart was hardened"

F. What do you think about this plague?

SIXTH PLAGUE-BOILS-EXODUS 9:8-12

A. God calls for Moses and Aaron to stand before Pharaoh v.8

1. They were to take handfuls of soot from a kiln
2. They were to throw it towards the sky in the sight of Pharaoh
3. What is missing that was part of the other plagues?

B. The soot will become fine dust over the land of Egypt v.9

1. It will become "boils"
2. "breaking out with sores on man and beast"

C. Moses did what God had told him to do v. 10

D. The magicians could not stand before Moses because of the boils v.11

1. The boils were on the magicians and all of the Egyptians
2. Who would be included in that? Why would that be important?

E. "The LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart v. 12

F. What do you think about this plague?

SEVENTH PLAGUE-HAIL-EXODUS 9:13-35

A. God sends a message to Pharaoh v.13-17

1. "Thus says the LORD, the God of the Hebrews" v.13
2. "Let my people go that they may serve me"
3. "For this time I will send all of my plagues on you..." v.14
4. "So that you may know that there is no one like me in all the earth"
5. "For if by now I had put forth my hand and struck you and your people with pestilence you would have been cut off from the earth" v.15
6. "But for this reason I have allowed you to remain" v. 16
 - a. Why did God allow Pharaoh to remain?
 - b. What is God telling Pharaoh?
7. "Still you exalt yourself against my people by not letting them go" v.17

B. God informs Pharaoh of what is coming v.18-21

1. "about this time tomorrow" v.18
2. "I will send forth a very heavy hail"
3. "such as has not been seen in Egypt from the day it was founded until now"
4. "therefore send, bring in your livestock and whatever you have in the field"
v.19
5. Notice what some of the servants of Pharaoh did v. 20,21

C. Moses stretched out his staff toward the sky v.22-26

1. "the LORD sent thunder and hail, and fire ran down to the earth" v.23,24
2. The hail struck all that was in the field v.25
3. In the land of Goshen there was no hail v.26

D. Pharaoh's response v.27,28

1. "I have sinned"
2. "this time"
3. "the LORD is the righteous one and I and my people are the wicked ones"
4. "Make supplication to the LORD"
5. "And I will let you go, and you shall stay no longer"

E. Moses' response v.29,30

1. "I will spread out my hands to the LORD"
2. "there will be hail no longer, that you may know that the earth is the LORD'S"
3. "But as for you and your servants, I know that you do not yet fear the LORD God"

F. The result of the hail v.31,32

G. Moses did what he had told Pharaoh he would do v.33-35

1. But when Pharaoh saw the hail stop he "sinned"

2. And Pharaoh hardened his heart
