Introduction:

1. Is making decisions easy or hard for you? Why?
2. What are some big decisions you have coming up in your life?

What do I think?

1. Do you think it's hard to find God's will for your life? Why or why not?
2. Which question in the decision-making process stood out to you? Why?
3. Which one is most difficult for you?

What does God say?

1. Read Romans 12:1-2 – How does Paul say we find God's will?
2. What does it mean to “be transformed by the renewing of your mind?”
3. Read Psalms 37:2-6 – What promises does God make in these verses?
4. What does the Psalm say we have to do to receive these promises?

What steps will I take?

1. What are some decisions right now where you may need to ask the WAIT questions? (Will it obey what God has said in His word? Am I going to grow closer to Christ? Is it wise according to God and others? Through this decision will others be led to Christ?)
2. Which of the following do you need to improve in your decision making: lean in to the Lord and trust Him, learn from the Lord or be led by the Lord?

Challenge:

This week commit to making wise decisions. Make sure you're spending time in God's word so that you can better discern His will. When you're faced with decisions in the coming days, take time to ask the WAIT questions and trust that God will reveal the best option for you.
